NB: HND must be from an accredited institution

3) DIPLOMA

- Must be Ghanaian by birth with no criminal record.
- Must possess a Diploma.
- Must have completed National Service.
- Must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 30 years by December 31, 2021.
- Must be physically and medically fit.
- Must be of good character.
- Must not be bonded.
- Must have a minimum height of 173 cm (5ft 8inch) for Males and 163 cm (5ft 4inch) for females.

4) DIPLOMA (STEENOGRAPHERS)

- Must be Ghanaian by birth with no criminal record.
- Must possess Diploma in Business Studies (Secretaryship Option) or an NVTI equivalent.
- Must have completed National Service.

- Must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 30 years by December 31, 2021.
- Must be physically and medically fit.
- Must be of good character.
- Must not be bonded.
- Must have a minimum height of 173 cm (5ft 8inch) for Males and 163 cm (5ft 4inch) for females.

NB: Diploma must be from an Accredited Institution.

5) HND [CATERING/INSTITUTIONAL MANAGEMENT]

- Must be Ghanaian by birth with no criminal record.
- Must possess HND in Hotel, Catering and Institutional Management.
- Must have completed National Service.
- Must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 30 years by December 31, 2021.
- Must be physically and medically fit.

- Must not be bonded.
- Must have a minimum height of 173 cm (5ft 8inch) for Males and 163 cm (5ft 4inch) for females.

6) DRESSMAKING/TAILORING

- Must be Ghanaian by birth with no criminal record.
- Must possess any of the following:
 - a. NVTI Certificate
 - b. GES Intermediate Certificate in Tailoring
 - c. GES or COVYET Certificate II in Tailoring
- Must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 30 years by December 31, 2021.
- Must be physically and medically fit.
- Must be of good character.
- Must not be bonded.
- Must have a minimum height of 173 cm (5ft 8inch) for Males and 163 cm (5ft 4inch) for females.

7) NON-GRADUATE ENTRY [RECRUITS - GENERAL DUTIES]

- All candidates are to satisfy the following requirements:

 - Must hold SSSCE/WASSCE Certificate with Five (5) passes including either English OR Maths
 - Must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 30 years by December 31, 2021.

 - Must not be bonded.
 - Must have a minimum height of 1.73 metres (5ft 8inch) for Males and 1.63 metres (5ft 4inch) for Female.

GHANA PRISONS SERVICE RECRUITMENT CRITERIA JUNIOR OFFICERS CATEGORY

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must:

- Be a Ghanaian.
- Be of good character and without any criminal record.
- Be physically and medically fit by Prisons Service standards.
- Be between 21 and 30 years by 31st December, 2021.
- Be between 21 and 35 years by 31st December, 2021 (for artisans and professionals only).
- Minimum academic qualification of BECE with at least five/5 passes.
- Not have been dismissed from any public service or any other employment.
- Be of minimum height of 1.68m (5'6") for males and 1.57m (5'2") for females.
- Be able to write and speak English fluently.
- Have active e-mail account and/or mobile phone number.
- Be ready to undergo basic Prisons training and other forms of training.
- Not be bonded.
- Be registered with the appropriate professional body and hold a valid PIN (for medical category).

CATEGORIES & THEIR REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL DUTIES

In addition to the general eligibility Applicants must possess SSCE/WASSCE with at least five/5 passes. Candidates with a pass in Maths or English will be an advantage.

2. MEDICAL CATEGORY

In addition to the General Eligibility, all applicants in this category must possess the specific qualification as specified below.

(i) GENERAL NURSES

At least a Diploma in Nursing (Registered General Nursing/Registered Mental Nursing/Registered Community Nursing/Emergency Nursing) and must have completed the mandatory rotation and registered with the Nursing & Midwifery Council.

HND in Dispensing Technology and must be a registered member of the Pharmacy Council

(iv) NURSE ANAESTHETIST

Must possess at least a Diploma in Anaesthetic Nursing, completed their rotation and be registered with the Nursing & Midwifery Council.

(v) OPHTHALMIC NURSES

Must possess at least a Diploma in Ophthalmic Nursing, completed their rotation and be registered with the Nursing & Midwifery Council.

(vi) ORTHOPAEDIC NURSES

Must possess at least a Diploma in Orthopaedic Nursing, completed their rotation and be registered with the Nursing & Midwifery Council.

(vii) NURSE ASSISTANT

Must possess certificate in Nurse Assistant clinical or Nurse Assistant Preventive, be registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Council.

3. AGRICULTURE CATEGORY

(i) AGRICULTURAL TECHNICAL OFFICERS

In addition to the General Eligibility applicants must possess at least a Diploma in Agriculture.

(ii) TRACTOR OPERATORS/MECHANICS

In addition to the General Eligibility, an applicant must possess at least one of the following certificates and should be able to repair tractors.

- Ghana Education Service (GES) Intermediate Certificate in one of the above.
- Ghana Education Service (GES) or COTVET Certificate II in one of the above.

(iii) AGRICULTURE TECHNICIANS

In addition to the General Eligibility, applicants must have one/1 year practical working experience, and must possess at least a technician certificate in the field of Agriculture.

Must possess a Professional Driver's Licence Class C or above which should not be less than one/1 year and at least any of the following qualifications.

- Ghana Education Service (GES) or COTVET Certificate II in Motor Vehicle Engineering/ Electrician.
- City and Guilds (Intermediate) Certificate in Internal Combustion Engines and Motor Vehicles/ Electrician.
- City and Guilds (Intermediate) Certificate in Motor Vehicle Engineering/ Electrician.
- NVTI 18, 11 or Trade Test Certificate II in Motor Vehicle Engineering/ Electrician.

6. TAILORS, TEXTILES & DESIGN AND COBBLERS/LEATHER WORK

Must possess at least any of the following in the areas specified:

- Ghana Education Service (GES) Intermediate Certificate in Tailoring, Textiles & Design or Cobblers/Leather Work.
- Ghana Education Service (GES) or COTVET Certificate II in Tailoring, Textiles & Design or Cobblers/Leather Work.
- NVTI 18, 11 or Trade Test Certificate II in Tailoring, Textiles & Design or Cobblers/Leather Work.
- City and Guilds (Intermediate) in Tailoring, Textiles & Design or Cobblers/Leather Work.

7. OFFICE & INDUSTRIAL MACHINE MECHANICS

- GES Intermediate Certificate/COTVET Certificate II in Office Machines or Industrial Mechanics
- City and Guilds Certificate in Electronics

8. STENOGRAPHERS/TYPIST

In addition to the General Eligibility, applicants must possess at least a Stenographer Certificate (COTVET/NVTI)/Stenographer I & II Certificates.

9. BANDSMEN

In addition to the General Eligibility applicants must possess at least Ghana Education Service (GES) Intermediate Certificate/ COTVET Certificate II/ NVTI Grade I or Trade Test Certificate II/ City and Guilds (Intermediate)/ or Proficiency in Basic Music (ABRSM) grade 4 and the following:

- Ability to sight-read musical notes.
- Ability to play Wood Wind or Brass Instruments and any other dance band Instrument.

10. CATERERS / COOKS

In addition to the General Eligibility, applicants must possess at least any of the following:

- NVTI Grade I or Trade Test Certificate II in Hospitality and Catering Management
- Ghana Education Service (GES) Intermediate Certificate or COTVET Certificate II in Hospitality and Catering Management.
- City and Guilds (Intermediate) in the above.

11. COMMUNICATION CATEGORY

In addition to the General Eligibility, all applicants in this category must possess specific qualification as specified below.

I. RADIO TECHNICIANS

Applicants must possess at least any of the following

- NVTI 18, 11/ City and Guilds Certificate in Electronics
- NVTI 18/ City and Guilds Certificate in Telecommunication

II. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT)

a. Network Administration

Applicants must possess at least N' Certificate from a recognised institution including knowledge in LINUX/Windows Server 2003, 2008 and above

b. Database Administration

Applicants must possess at least Certificate in My SQL, SQL and Oracle from a recognised institution.

c. Web Designing

Applicants must possess at least Certificate in HTML, PHP, CSS, CMS, Adobe and Photoshop from a recognised institution.

12. SPORTSMEN/WOMEN

The sporting disciplines are as follows

- Taekwondo

In addition to the General Eligibility applicants in the above disciplines must be of a minimum age of 18 and not more than 25 years by 31st December, 2021

NOTE

For the junior officer's category, it must be noted that apart from applicants with Diploma/HND in Agriculture and Health related programmes as indicated in serial 2 & 3 that will be placed on the rank of Sergeant, all other applicants shall start from Second Class Officer Rank after completion of training.

Artisans, bandsmen/women and sportsmen/women who are selected will assemble at the Prison Officers Training School in Accra for a practical test. The date and time for the test will be communicated to them in the course of the recruitment process.

- Must have a minimum height of 1.67metres (5ft 6inches) for Males and 1.57 metres (5ft 2inches) for Female.
- Must have an active e-mail account and/or mobile phone number.
- Be ready to undergo paramilitary Training and other physical training.
- Medical professionals must have completed one year post housemanship with a registered hospital or clinic.

1. GENERAL DUTIES

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have a minimum of first degree in any of the following areas. Any additional qualification will be an added advantage.

2. AGRICULTURE

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least first degree in the following area and a minimum of one (1) year post qualification working experience.

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must at least possess Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) and a permanent registered member of the Medical and Dental Council and with one (1) year post qualification experience.

(d) PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must at least possess B.Sc. Physician Assistant or B.Sc. Medical Assistant, be a registered member of the Medical and Dental Council and with one (1) year post qualification experience.

(e) MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGIST

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must at least possess B.Sc. Medical Laboratory Technology, be a registered member of the Allied Health Professions Council and with one (1) year post qualification experience.

(f) NURSING OFFICERS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least BSc Nursing, be registered with the Nursing and Midwives Council of Ghana and with one (1) year post qualification experience.

7. PROCUREMENT/SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least first degree in Procurement/Supply chain management.

8. PUBLIC AFFAIRS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least:

- First degree in any of the following: Communication Studies, Public Relations or Journalism.
- A first degree in any discipline plus a Diploma in Communication Studies/Public Relations/ Journalism.

Previous working experience will be an added advantage.

9. STATISTICIANS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least first degree in Statistics or Mathematics.

10. TECHNICAL OFFICERS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must have at least first degree or equivalent in the following areas:

- BSc Land Economy
- Building Technology
 - BSc Quantity Surveying and Construction Technology
 - BSc Construction Technology and Management
- BSc Civil Engineering
- BSc Mechanical Engineering
- BSc Electrical Engineering

Previous working experience will be an added advantage.

11. RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS

In addition to the general eligibility, applicants must be:

(a) ORDAINED MINISTER OR CHAPLAIN

Have at least a first degree in Theology. Be of good standing in a Christian denomination approved by any of the following bodies, the Ghana Catholic Secretariat, the Christian Council of Ghana, the Pentecostal Council of Ghana or other recognized Christian bodies.

(b) IMAM

- Have at least a first degree in Islamic Studies with an excellent knowledge in Arabic.

(ii) Be of good standing in a Muslim denomination approved by any of the following bodies the Office of the National/Regional Chief Imam, the office of the Ameer of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Mission or other similar nationally recognized Muslim bodies.

NOTE:

For the Senior officer's category apart from Medical Doctors, Dental Surgeon, Pharmacist with (Pharm D) and Legal officers as indicated in serial 5 & 6 that will be placed on the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Prisons (DSP), all other graduates shall start from Assistant Superintendent of Prisons (ASP) after completion of training.

- Use your Serial Number (SN) and Pin Code (PIN) to access the application form online at the website address: www.applyghprisons.com.
- All applicants must have a passport size picture of dimensions 200x200 pixels of JPEG/JPG/PNG with size not exceeding 1.0MB ready to be uploaded.
- Carefully read ALL INSTRUCTIONS before you apply.
- The online application form is accessible only by the SN and PIN.
- Keep your UNIQUE NUMBER on the summary report for all the stages of the recruitment and selection process.
- ALL correspondence with applicants will be done through e-mail, text messages and the e-recruitment portal only.
- Only Short listed Applicants will be invited for further stages of the recruitment and the enlistment exercise.

RECRUITMENT AND ENLISTMENT PROCESS

- Applicants who meet the initial requirements will be short-listed and invited to centres they selected during the online application.
- Short-listed applicants will be invited for the following:
 - Physical and Body screening
 - Inspection and verification of all necessary documents
 - Ability Test
- Artisans, sportsmen/women and bandmen who are successful in Item 2 above will go through a competency based assessment in ACTA.
- Applicants who are shortlisted after items 2 and 3 above will undergo a medical examination at a medical facility selected by the Service.
- Results submitted during the application process shall be verified at WAEC and other appropriate examination bodies hence Applicants who present false documents would be arrested and prosecuted.
- Applicants who are successful in Item 4 above will go through a thorough criminal an background check.
- Applicants who are cleared of criminal records will be invited to commence training.

GENERAL DUTY RECRUITS, TRADESMEN GRADUATES (GENERAL DUTY AND PROFESSIONALS)



1. The Ghana Police Service will from 27th August, 2021 offer employment opportunity for qualified Ghanaians who are interested in Law Enforcement to apply to join the Police Service. The available categories are General Duty Recruits, Tradesmen Recruits, Graduates (General Duty) and Graduates Professionals. There are sub-categories of Tradesmen and Graduate Professionals. However, all Applicants must satisfy all general requirements in addition to specific requirements for a chosen category/sub category. The application process shall be originated online; therefore, physical submission of application forms shall not be accepted.

2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS-

All Applicants shall satisfy these requirements in addition to the specific requirement for a specific category. An Applicant must:

- a. be a Ghanaian by birth;
- b. be of good character;
- c. be without criminal records;
- d. not have been dismissed from any public service or any other employment;
- e. not be more than the age stated for a specific category by 01/12/2021
- f. be at least 5 feet 8 inches (173cm) tall for males and 5 feet 4 inches (163cm) for females;
- g. be physically and medically fit by Ghana Police Service standards;
- h. possess BECE Certificate
- i. be ready to undergo basic Police training and other forms of training;
- j. graduate applicants must have completed National Service.

3. CATEGORIES OF ENTRY:

 - ii. must hold a Diploma in any field of study from a recognized University, Polytechnic or any Tertiary Institution accredited by the Ghana Accreditation Board.

- In addition to the general requirements, an Applicant who applies to this category must satisfy the requirements stated under the specific sub-category:

 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have any of the under listed minimum qualifications with not less than two (2) years post qualification working experience.
 - a. BA Communication Studies;
 - b. BA Journalism;
 - c. BA Public Relations;
 - d. BA English Language;
 - e. BA Photography.
 - f. HND/Diploma in Communication Studies, Journalism, Public Relations And Photography
 - ii. LANGUAGE SPECIALIST:
 - a. Bi-Lingual: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant:
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have a degree in one of French, Spanish, Chinese or Arabic.
 - must be fluent in one of French, Spanish, Chinese or Arabic.
 - iii. LEGAL OFFICERS (LAWYERS): In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have been called to the Bar and must have completed pupillage in addition to having a valid license to practice in Ghana.
 - must be a member of the Ghana Bar Association in good standing.
 - iv. CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have MPhil in Clinical Psychology or Masters in Counseling;
 - must have been registered with the GPC as a professional with minimum of 2 years working experience in the field besides internship.
 - v. MEDICAL SPECIALIST: An applicant must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.

- must have MB ChB/BDS or its equivalent from a recognized College; plus, a relevant Post Graduate qualification to the level of Membership/Fellowship of the Ghana College of Physicians and Surgeons (GCPS/WACS/WACP) in addition to at least two (2) years post qualification experience in any of the following professions:
 - a. General Surgeons;
 - b. Obstetrics / Gynecologists;
 - c. Physician Specialist;
 - d. Ophthalmology;
 - e. Ear Nose and Throat;
 - f. Doctor Anesthetist.
 - g. Othopaedic Surgeon
 - h. Psychiatrist
 - i. Plastic Surgeon
 - j. Dental Surgeon
 - k. Emergency Physician Specialists
- vi. PHARMACIST: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must possess a minimum of Bachelor of Pharmacy Degree (BPharm) (at least Second-class Lower Division) or Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) from a university accredited by the Ghana Accreditation Board,
 - be registered with the Pharmacy Council and the Pharmaceutical Society of Ghana with at least one(1) year post National Service working experience as a pharmacist.
- vii. MEDICAL DOCTORS: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have MB ChB/BDS or its equivalent in addition to a permanent registration with the Ghana Medical and Dental Council
 - must have at least one (1) year post qualification working experience in a recognised health facility.
- viii. RADIOLOGIST: In addition to the general requirements an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must be a member of Ghana College of Physicians and Surgeons or West African College of Physicians.
- ix. SONOGRAPHERS: In addition to the general requirements an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have Bsc in Sonography.
- x. CERTIFIED REGISTERED ANAESTHETIST: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 35 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must have Bsc or Advance Diploma in Anaesthesia.
- xi. MEDICAL LABORATORY ASSISTANTS: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 30 years by 01/12/2021
 - must have SSSCE/WASSCE together with Certificate in Medical Laboratory Technology plus two (2) years post qualification internship.
- xii. HEALTH INFORMATICS: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - Must not be more than 30 years by 01/12/2021
 - must have a degree, HND or Diploma in health Statistics.
- xiii. NURSING SERVICES: In addition to the general requirements, an applicant
 - must not be more than 30 years by 01/12/2021.
 - must be registered with the Nursing & Midwifery Council
 - must possess at least a Diploma in the relevant area of Nursing listed below;
 - a. ENT Nurses;
 - b. Intensive Care Nurses;
